Established in 2013, The Futures Trust (TFT) is a Multi-Academy of three Secondary and three Primary Schools, five of which are based in the Coventry area. The Trust is passionate about improving outcomes for their learners, staff and communities. They've developed models and services to help schools improve and enhance.

When the Trust was looking for an IT partner to deliver one, single Trust-wide network, a previous relationship meant they approached Virtue to see how our service could meet their needs.



The Challenge

The Futures Trust wanted an IT partner who could deliver a single network that all the school sites could sit on. When their previous supplier was unable to deliver, TFT were on the lookout for a new partner who could.

The Trust's ICT Manager, Olan Adeyemi, approached Virtue after working with us at a previous school to see if we could support them and what we'd suggest.

In addition to the infrastructure challenges The Futures Trust presented, we knew that several of the school's IT Teams were used to working with their own IT support companies, and some were resistant to change.

When I realised that our previous supplier couldn't deliver on our vision of a single IT network, I was worried that it was too ambitious a plan. However, having worked with Virtue before and knowing their technical expertise, I wanted to see if they could help.

The Solution

Working with the Existing Teams

Firstly, we set about understanding the needs and concerns of the individual school IT Teams and alleviating their fears of working with a new IT company. We explained that we see our relationships with schools as partnerships. And most importantly, that our dedicated in-house specialists are an extension of their team, an additional support who are experts in their field; they're not a replacement for the school's IT Teams.

Precise Planning through Site Surveys

Our next step was to perform a full survey of each site. We needed to understand if each school's infrastructure was fit-for-purpose. In fact each Primary needed new servers, as did one of the secondary schools, President Kennedy School. The school was actually in the process of procuring these and we were able to help them refine their requirements to save them money. We also re-purposed the existing kit at the remaining Secondary Schools and upgraded them to reduce costs and help them maximise their budgets.

Building a Budget-friendly Backup Solution

As part of our infrastructure design for The Futures Trust, we also developed a trust-wide backup solution. To maximise the Trust's budget, each site has it's own local backup of their data and, another one of the trust schools also holds its own copy. Backups are run overnight to avoid impact on teaching and learning in the day. This solution enables speedy disaster recovery and provides scalability. It also means the schools don't need an external 3rd party backup solution which reduces costs.
