



St. George's C of E Primary

With just over 200 pupils, St. George's provides a positive and welcoming environment for the 5-11 year olds it supports. The co-educational single form entry Primary School is set in the Barbourne area, within the historical city of Worcester. The school aims to give their pupils the opportunity to grow in an atmosphere of mutual love and respect.

When searching for a new internet provider, they turned to local high school Pershore for advice before choosing their new service provider.

The Challenge

The Solution

Following Pershore's recommendation, we wanted to highlight to St. George's that we could fulfil their requirements at a Primary Sector level, as well as building larger solutions as we'd done with Pershore.

We spoke to Pershore's Andrew King as their IT advisor as well as St. George's Headteacher Gill Gittins about the school's needs. We knew the school has gone to other providers for quotes and while we weren't sure we'd provide the cheapest solution, we were confident we'd offer the most cost-effective one.

Knowing that the school wanted to get a fast, reliable connection to the internet, we suggested a line with speeds that would allow them to access data quickly and efficiently, without being cost prohibitive. Now the teachers know they can access their online resources, whenever they need them, logon to an online classroom or stream a YouTube video and their connection will simply work. Now St. George's internet supports teaching and learning, instead of acting as a barrier to it.

We also looked into the school's wider IT infrastructure requirements and suggested they bolster their security. In order to do so, we provided Sophos XG Firewall and EnterpriseGuard creating layered network, web and firewall protection as well as device and server protection for the school.
